Clerk of the Court




 An official in charge of the records and accounts of a court

• The division of power between the state and federal government.




Delegate


Reserved Powers



• Powers the Constitution given to the states (10th Amendment)

TENTH AMENDMENT

The powers not delegated to the United States by the Constitution, nor prohibited by it to the States, are reserved to the States respectively, or to the people.

• An interest bearing certificate issued by a government that promises to pay the holder money by a specific date.





Treasurer



• An elected official who ensures the economic vitality by the collection of revenue for a city





City Manager

• A person hired by the Legislative branch to oversee the operation of the local government






Ordinances




• Chief executive of a locality and representative of a city government






Board of Supervisors

• Elected officials in a **town** that carry out legislative powers.






City Council
